

# Overview

The Level 3 International Foundation Diploma for Higher Education Studies (L3IFDHES) is a one-year pre-university qualification that equips students with essential skills in English, mathematics, research, and study techniques. This programme prepares students for direct entry into the first year of an undergraduate degree at internationally recognized universities, covering various disciplines from law and finance to engineering and art.

# **Entry Requirements**

For entry onto the NCC Education Level 3 International Foundation Diploma for Higher Éducation Studies (L3IFDHES) qualification:

Students must meet the following entry requirements:

- Completed their GCSE/IGCSE 'O' Levels or an equivalent\* qualification in their own country and passed 5 subjects with minimum grades of 'C', '4' or equivalent\* in each. These should include Mathematics and English.
- Have a valid score of 4.5 or above in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination or equivalent for students whose first language is not English.

Alternatively, students can take the free NCC Education Standard English Placement Test which is administered by our Accredited Partner Centres.

\* Centres need to provide evidence to justify any equivalency decision (both qualification non-standard routes.

Students must choose the preferred combination of units to the total value of 120 units.\*


- (A) 4 core + 2 elective (both 20-credit)
